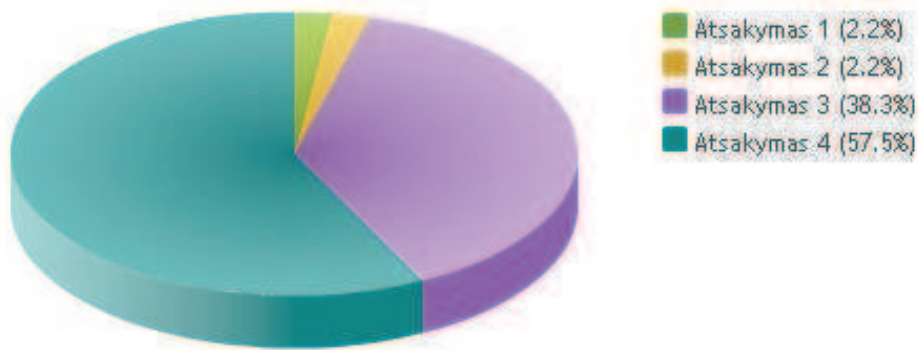


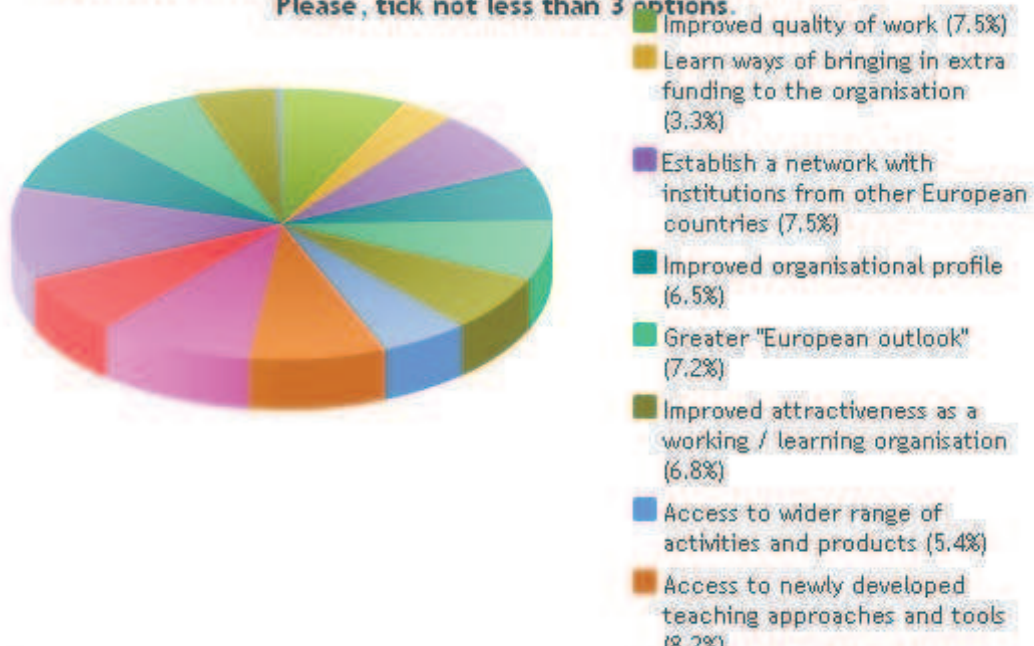

Are the main project aims and objectives attained?

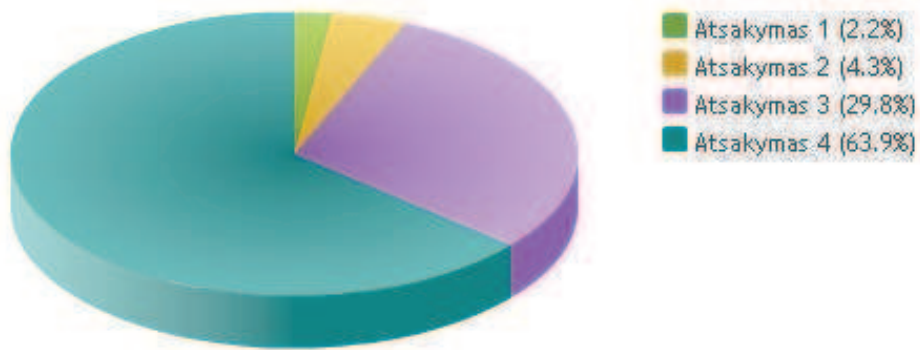


What have been the main benefits of the project to your organisation?

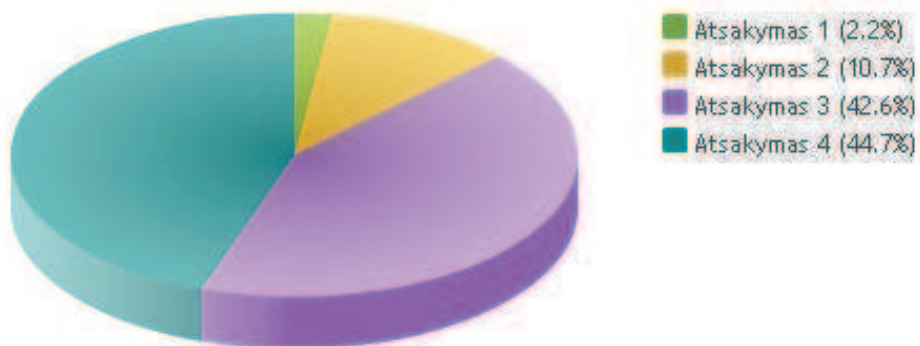

What have been the main benefits to the staff?



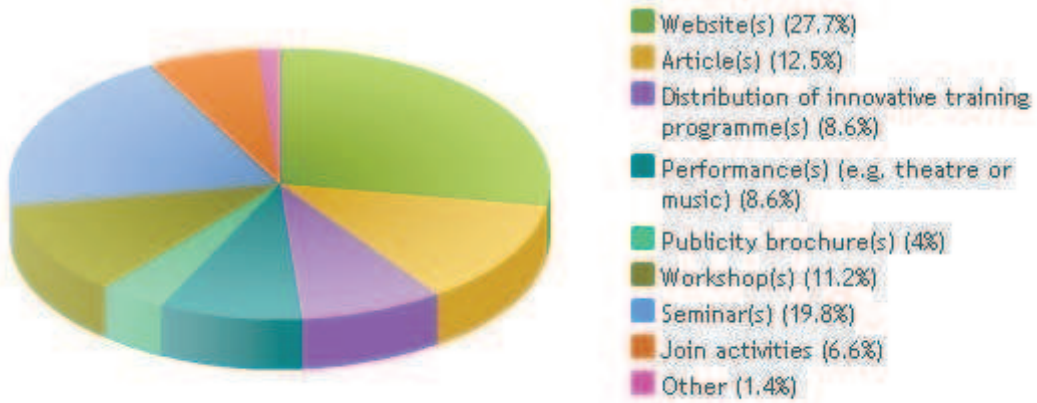
- Improvement of project management skills (12.7%)

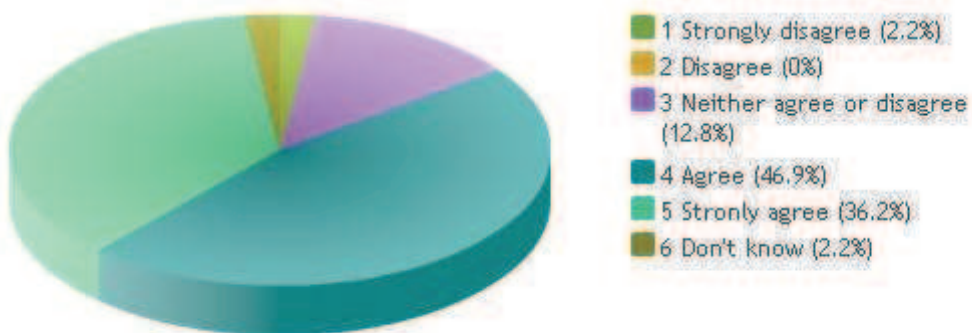


- Wider range of learning tools (8.6%)

- Improvement of international mobility opportunities (6.3%)

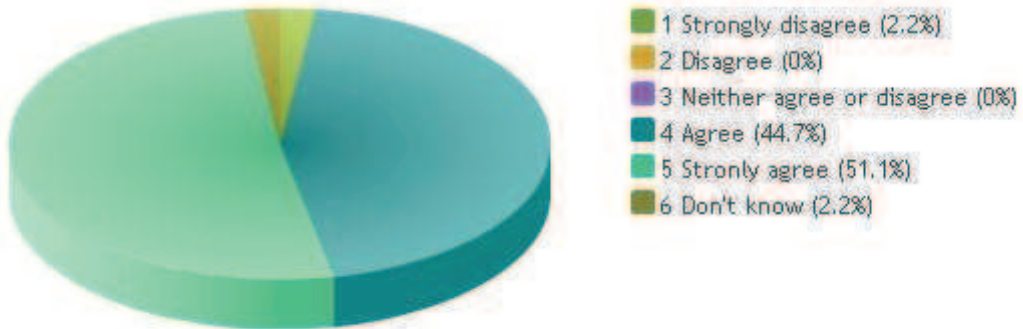

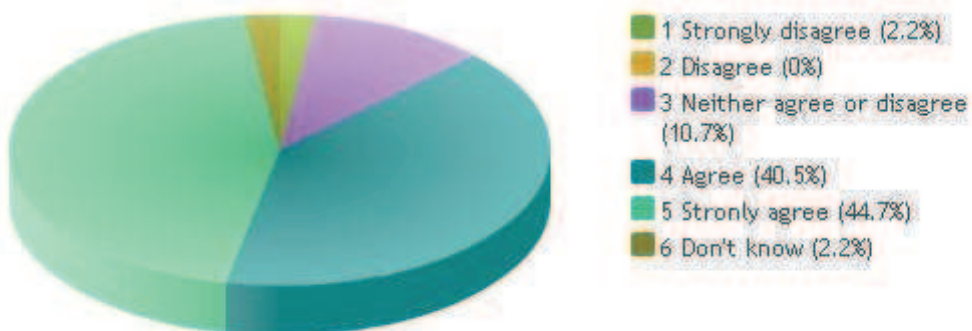
